#2 The most famous rule: White wine with fish, Red Wine with Meat

#3 For a comfortable wine- and- food match, the wine should be at least as full-bodied as the food it accompanies. Therefore you can choose a red wine with fish or a white wine with beef, if you are so inclined, and make a good match. A light red wine can be matched with broiled salmon and a rich, full-bodied Chardonnay can handle roast beef.

#4 There is no right or wrong
