112c	<u>Cinq Cepages</u>	Chateau St Jean 2014	A full complex wine with black cherry, plum and spice with a long finish.	110.00
113b	<u>Cabernet Sauvignon</u>	Carr 2015	This wine displays a deep purple hue, and has great clarity for wine that is traditionally unfiltered.	36.00
114c	<u>Cabernet</u>	Beaulieu Vineyard 2008	This George Latour wine is complex and elegant with plum, blackberry and spice flavors with a long finish.	169.00

#2 The most famous rule: White wine with fish, Red Wine with Meat

#3 For a comfortable wine- and- food match, the wine should be at least as full-bodied as the food it accompanies. Therefore, you can choose a red wine with fish or a white wine with beef, if you are so inclined, and make a good match. A light red wine can be matched with broiled salmon and a rich, full-bodied Chardonnay can handle roast beef.
